REGULATIONS of the "Second World Nomad Games"





Cholpon-Ata, Kyrgyzstan, 2016



I. Purposes and Objectives

World Nomad Games (hereinafter referred to as "WNG") having specific traditions and ethno-cultural heritage have the following purposes and objectives:

1. Preserving WNG as the cultural heritage of the nomadic civilization and promoting ethnosport movement in the world;

2. Popularizing and developing ethnic types of sport, traditional games and competitions of the nomadic people.

3. Preserving and developing ethnic culture of the world

4. Contributing to further scientific, organizational and methodical basis of ethno movement;

5. Strengthening and further developing friendship, harmony and cooperation among the people of the world.

II. Date and Venue

The Games are held once every two years. The host country is determined by the decision of the Council of Heads of States (CHS) of the Cooperation Council of the Turkic Speaking States (Turkic Council) with the mutual consent of the Member States of the Turkic Council.

The Second WNG will be held on 3-8 September 2016 in Cholpon-Ata, Kyrgyz Republic.

Location: Cholpon-Ata city, Issyk-Kul region, Kyrgyz Republic Arrival day: 1-2 September 2016. Registration of delegations: 2 September 2016. Opening ceremony of the Second WNG: 3 September 2016. Closing ceremony of the Second WNG: 8 September 2016. Day of Departure of delegations: 9 September 2016, by 14.00.

III. Participation

Countries can take part in the competitions listed in the programme of the Second WNG after on-time submission of the applications.

IV. Management

General management and conduct of the Second WNG is done by the Organizing Committee, to be established by the Host Country and comprising officials from the Member States and the Secretariat of the Turkic Council. Direct supervision for preparing and conducting the Second WNG will be carried out by the State Agency for Youth Affairs, Physical Culture and Sports under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic (State Agency).

The Host Country, in coordination with the Organizing Committee, and through the written request of the participating countries, if any, approves the programme of the competitions of the Second WNG.



The Host country of the WNG prepares flag, anthem, emblem, and mascot of the games, which will become part of souvenirs.

The flag and emblem of the Turkic Council will be also used during the Second WNG, including the opening and closing ceremonies.

Competitions on national sports and folk games will be staged in accordance with the types and rules set out in the Annex to this present Regulation.

V. Responsibilities

The Host country is responsible for the following:

- organizing the Second WNG (sport section)

- meeting and accompanying the foreign delegations (leaders, athletes, referees, coaches);

- providing meals and accommodation for the foreign delegations (on arrival);

- providing food and accommodation for dogs birds and horses (on arrival);

- providing transportation for the delegations from Bishkek to Cholpon-Ata and back; and all transfers during the competitions;

- covering round-trip transportation costs for the sports delegation of the Kyrgyz Republic, including coaches, organization committee, working groups, referees, medical staff and all transfers during the competition;

- providing rent of transports and equipment;

- providing sports equipment, medicines as well as supplementary technical and sport equipments for the sports delegation of the Kyrgyz Republic;

- preparing the locations for the competitions;

- providing required security measures

Responsibility for preparation and organization of the opening and closing ceremonies of the Second WNG and cultural events are carried out by the Ministry of Culture, Information and Tourism of the Kyrgyz Republic and the State Agency.

The cost of foreign participants, coaches and referees to the competition (international ticket fares, meals, horse hay and forage as well as safe delivery of horses, maintaining wages) is borne by the sending countries.

The Organizing Committee is not responsible for accidents (athlete's injuries during the training and competition, the death of horses, etc.). Foreign delegations are supposed to insure their delegations and animals from accidents during the competitions.

Veterinary and customs procedures related to the transportation of animals are carried out under the law of the host country. The host country will take necessary measures to facilitate the customs procedures.

VI. High Council of Referees

The High Council of Referees (Council) comprising the representatives of the Member States of the Turkic Council (one representative from each country) is established and approved by the Organizing Committee. The Council consists of the Chairperson and its members. All decisions of the Council are taken collectively. In case of any disputes, a member of the Council whose country issues the protest does not participate in the decision-making.



The Council is entitled to cancel earlier decisions made by relevant referees on respective sport types.

"Protests"

In case of any disputes, the head of the sport delegation can submit a protest to the relevant referees not later than 1 hour after a dispute has arisen.

In case the parties are not satisfied with the decision made by the relevant referees, the protest shall be submitted to the Council by 21:00 of the same day. The protest shall be submitted in a written form with a formal registered decision (protocol) by the relevant referees and obligatory provision of video and photo materials.

VII. Special Conditions

If the foreign teams participating in "Kok boru", "Er enish", "Chong at chabysh", "At chabysh", "Jorgo salysh", "Kunan chabysh" games, for whatever reason, cannot bring their own horses, should notify the State Agency by 7 August 2016. Teams meeting the above condition will be provided with appropriate animals by the host country. The host country will take necessary measures for the selection of appropriate animals by the foreign teams.

Any participating country of the Second WNG may represent its national game at its own expense.

Each participating country should provide national dress and equipment for its sport delegation (athletes, coaches and officials). Each participating country is also required to provide its own national anthem and flag in advance.

VIII. Application Procedure

Preliminary applications for participation in the Second WNG should be submitted by 7 July 2016 and revised applications by 7 August 2016 to the Directorate for National Sports under the State Agency. The applications must contain full name of sport managers, referees, coaches and athletes with their initials and their photos (4x6, 2 pcs.) in electronic format. Please refer to info@worldnomadgames.com for the submission of the above-mentioned documents, as well as for any further query.

The participants in equestrian sports competitions must have a medical certificate (with all vaccinations) and insurance certificate with them (for kok-boru, at chabysh, jorgo salysh, kunan chabysh, er enish).

Certificate of veterinarian permitting a horse to take part in competition should be submitted to the mandated Commission.

All necessary information concerning all kinds of certificates and insurances will be provided in the official web site of the Second WNG.

Upon arrival of the teams, it is necessary to bring and submit an application to the mandated Commission, which must contain full name of a participant, his/her sport rank, of trainer – horse-



breaker, owner of a horse, age, color and breed of the horse with one photo of it attached to the application. Besides it is necessary to submit a certificate from the public authority confirming horse's identity.

Athletes under the age of 18 must obtain all permits to participate in the competition in accordance with the laws of the home country.

Each country has the right to present its ethnic type of sports and national games, if it so wishes, in the form of the demonstration competitions which aren't part of the programme of the Second WNG. The programme of such games will be prepared in accordance with the applications of the participating countries.

IX. Awarding

The teams that win prizes in competitions at the Second WNG will be awarded with cups, medals and diplomas as well as other attributes and cash prizes defined by the State Agency and Organizing Committee.

X. Opening and Closing Ceremonies

Opening ceremony

Cultural heritage of the host country as well as nomadic peoples will be presented by a theatrical performance before the parade of the national teams.

National teams will march in separate groups in the alphabetical order of the names of the countries in English. A representative of the host country leads each national team by carrying a sign with the name of the participating country. He/she will be followed by the standard-bearer carrying the flag of the participating country.

After the parade the Head of the host country makes a welcome speech, raises the flag of the Second WNG, and the anthem of the Second WNG is performed. Then the flag of the host country is raised and its national anthem is sung.

One of the athletes or officials of the host country takes the oath on behalf of all athletes and referees for fair play and competition.

Closing ceremony

Theatrical performances are staged by the host country before the speech of the Head of the host country or another official on his behalf, which will be followed by the parade of national teams.

The Head of the host country or another official on his behalf announces the closing of the Second WNG, followed by a performance of the anthems of the Host country and of the Second WNG.

After the completion of the Second WNG the baton is passed to the host country of the next WNG.



XI. Final Provision

The present Regulation adopted by the Ministers in charge of Youth and Sport of the Turkic Council.

TYPES AND RULES OF THE GAMES

1. The national game "Ordo" (Kyrgyz Republic).

2. Horse racing:

- 2.1 "Chong at chabysh" racing to the far distance.
- 2.2 "At chabysh" a long-distance racing.
- 2.3 "Jorgo salysh" racing on the pacers.
- 2.4 "Kunan chabysh" racing on the two-year olds (stallions).

3. Horse competitions:

- 3.1 "Kok-boru" Kyrgyz national team competition on horseback.
- 3.2 "Er enish" wrestling on horseback.
- 3.3 "Cirit"-competition on horseback with javelin.

4. Festival of martial arts:

- 4.1 "Alysh" belt wrestling (Kyrgyz Republic).
- 4.2 "Kyrgyz Kurosh" the national wrestling (Kyrgyz Republic).
- 4.3 "Kazakh kuresh" the national wrestling (Republic of Kazakhstan).
- 4.4 "Goresh" the national wrestling (Turkmenistan).
- 4.5 "Gyulesh" the national wrestling (Republic of Azerbaijan).
- 4.6 "Aba Kurosh" the national wrestling (Turkish Republic).
- 4.7 "Mass-wrestling" a national contest (Russian Federation).

5. Contest of the traditional archers bow:

- 5.1 "Joo jaa atuu" Hiking shooting
- 5.2 "Atchan jaa atuu" Horseback shooting
- 5.3 "Mass bow range and accuracy".

The following countries are used target and the distance: China, Hungary, Japan, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, South Korea, Turkey, the United States and others by the suggestion from the countries participating.

6. The traditional intellectual games:

- 6.1 "Toguz korgool" (Kyrgyz Republic).
- 6.2 "Mangala" (Republic of Turkey)

7. Sports competitions in national kinds of hunting ''Salbuurun'' (The Kyrgyz Republic)

- 7.1 "Burkut Saluu": "Chyrga", "Undok".
- 7.2 "Dalba oynotuu".
- 7.3 "Taigan jarysh".



Composition of the team - 10 people: 7 players, 1 substitute player, 1 coach, 1 leader. Each team must have 7 tompoys 70 alchiks and sportswear with a number.

If two teams earn equal points, the winner is:

a) The team to win a personal meeting;

b) Depending on the number and knocked chuko (alchiks) by knocking out Khan. Notching tompoy not exceed 15 mm.

2. HORSE RACING

2.1. " Chong at chabysh" - racing to the far distance.

Composition of the team - 4 people: 2 riders, 1 coach, 1 veterinarian. Riders must be over 18 years old. To competitions 4 year old (and above) horses of all breeds.

Competitions are held at a distance of 80 km.

The team of Kyrgyzstan consists of 21 horses (3 racers from each region).

2.2. "At Chabysh" - a long-distance racing.

Composition of the team - 3 people: 2 riders, 1 coach. Riders over 12 years old are allowed to participate. The races can include horses of all breeds older than 3 years. Races are held at a distance of 22 km.

The team of Kyrgyzstan consists of 21 horses (3 racers from each region).

2.3. "Jorgo salysh" - racing on the pacers.

Composition of the team - 2 people: 1 rider, 1 coach. The competition is for riders over 12 years old. The competition is held at a distance of 11 km.

The team of Kyrgyzstan consists of 21 pacers (3 pacers from each region).

2.4. "Kunan chabysh" - racing two years olds.

Composition of the team - 3 people: 2 riders, 1 coach. Riders over 12 years old are allowed to participate in the competitions. For competitions allowed stallions of all breeds aged between 2 to 3 years. The competition is held at a distance of 11 km.

The team of Kyrgyzstan consists of 21 stallions (3 stallions from each region).

3. HORSE COMPETITIONS:

3.1. "Kok-boru" - Kyrgyz national team competition on horseback.

Composition of the team - 17 people: 12 players, 1 leader, 1 coach, 3 riders. Men over 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions.

Winners and typesetting points:

- Awarded to the winners - 2 points;

- Addressing a score draw - 1 point;

- Loser - 0 points.

3.2. "Er enish" - wrestling on horseback.

Composition of the team - 4 people: 3 athletes of 70 kg, 90 kg and over 90 kg, 1 coach. Wrestlers older than 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions. Each participant must have two zones of different colours. The competition is conducted on a one-to-one. Participant won a «clear victory» earns 4 points, winner participant earns 3 points, a draw is



not accepted, and the loser participants earn 0 points. Loser participant outs of the game. Participants in the semi-final losers vie for third place.

3.3. "Cirit" - competition on horseback with javelin.

The game is played on an arena indicated by white lines of 120x40. The length of the javelin is 110 cm. Each team consists of 7 riders and two substitutes. Players can be changed any time, provided the referees are_notified. The player that got out the game may re-enter the game. The game is played as two periods, each 40 minutes. The total duration of the game is 80 minutes, and the break is 10 minutes. The pause during the periods are added to the end of that period. The maximum attack period is 35 seconds. At the 20th second of the attack period the rider is warned by the referee. If the attacker will not throw his javelin within that period he takes one penalty point, and his team makes one more attack. If the next attacker will also not throw his javelin he takes 2 penalty points. The result of the game is determined by the points. The penalty points are subtracted from the attack points, and the team that gathered the most attack point wins the game.

4. FESTIVAL OF MARTIAL ARTS

4.1. "Alysh" - belt wrestling.

Composition of the team - 14 people: 12 fighters (6 men, 6 women), 1 coach, 1 judge. Wrestlers older than 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions.

Competitions are held in the following weight categories:

- Men: 60 kg, 70 kg, 80 kg, 90 kg; 100 kg; + 100 kg;

- Women: 55 kg, 60 kg, 65 kg, 70 kg, 75 kg, + 75 kg.

4.2. "Kyrgyz kurosh" - Kyrgyz national wrestling.

Composition of the team - 8 people: 7 athletes, 1 coach. Athletes older 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions. Competitions are held among men in the following weight categories:

- 55 kg, 60 kg, 66 kg, 74 kg, 84 kg, 96 kg, + 96 kg.

Won the match gets the Cup "Khan Koshoy." He becomes the guest of honour at the next Games, and gets the right to personally award the champion of these games. Competitions are held under the rules of the Federation "Kyrgyz kurosh".

4.3. "Kazakh kuresh" - Kazakh wrestling.

Composition of the team - 7 people: 5 athletes, 1 coach and 1 referee. Competitions are held among men in the following weight categories:

- 60 kg, 70 kg, 80 kg, 90 kg; + 90 kg.

Wrestlers older than 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions. The fight is carried on a special mat. Competitions are held under the rules of the Federation "Kazakh kuresh».

4.4. "Goresh" - Turkmen national wrestling.

Composition of the team - 4 people: 2 athletes, 1 coach, 1 judge. Competitions are held among men in open weight category over 80 kg. Wrestlers older than 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions. The fight is carried on a special mat. Competitions are held under the rules of the Federation "Turkmen goresh"



4.5. "Gyulesh" - Azerbaijan wrestling.

Composition of the team - 8 peoples: 6 athletes, 1 coach and 1 referee. Competitions are held among men in the following weight categories:

- 50 kg, 60 kg, 70 kg, 80 kg, 90 kg, + 90 kg.

Wrestlers older than 18 years are allowed to competitions. The fight is carried on a special mat. The competition is held under the rules of the Federation "Azerbaijan gyulesh."

4.6. "Aba Guresh" - Turkish national wrestling.

Composition of the team - 3 people: 1 coach, 2 athletes. The competition is held among men in open weight category over 80 kg.

The competition is held under the rules of the Federation "Aba kurosh."

4.7. "Mas-wrestling" (tayak tartysh).

Composition of the team - 15 people: 7 men, 5 women, 1 leader, 1 coach, 1 judge.

Athletes over 18 years are allowed to take part in competitions. The competition is held on the weight categories:

- Men: 60 kg, 70 kg, 80 kg, 90 kg, 105 kg, 125 kg and + 125 kg;

- Women: 55 kg, 65 kg, 75 kg, 85 kg + 85 kg.

The competition is held according to the rules adopted by the International Federation of "Mas-wrestling."

5. CONTEST OF THE TRADITIONAL ARCHERS BOW:

5.1 "Hiking shooting"

5.2 "Horseback Shooting

5.3 "Mass bow range and accuracy".

Composition of the team - 16 people: 13 participants (10 men, 3 women), 2 coach, 1 judge. Participants older than 16 years are allowed to take part in competitions. Competitions are held among men and women.

In this type of competition will apply those target countries participating in the games that have confirmed their participation.

Each country should provide his team with bow, arrow and target. Size, weight, and shape of the bow and arrow are irrelevant.

6. THE TRADITIONAL INTELLECTUAL GAMES:

6.1. "Toguz korgool"

Composition of the team - 5 people: 2 men, 2 women, 1 coach. The competition is conducted individually and in groups. In the individual competition according to the Swiss order in the group competition after two defeats the team was eliminated. If the number of teams is fewer than five it is a round system - aylampa (circuit). The results are fed separately between male and female teams. Each player is given 1 hour for holding one game.

Winning player scored 1 point, a draw is estimated at 0.5 points, and the loser 0 points are counted. In the group competition winners are determined according to the results of personal meetings. In case of a tie in the number of stones read losing matches: who has the most stones, and he wins. If an equal number of stones, it takes into account the result of the



first board. When individual account is taken into account the number of points if the points score is equal, is considered Buhgolz system; if the ratio is equal to Buhgolz, it is considered an individual account. In case of a tie, the coefficient of increase is considered.

All competitors must be dressed in national clothes of their country (the dress code). Issues not stipulated in this paragraph shall be solved according to the "Toguz korgool" Code of the Kyrgyz Republic.

6.2."Mangala"

Mangala game is played by two persons. The game board consists of 12 small pits arranged in two parallel rows with 6 pits in each row and each player has one big treasury where he is going to collect his pieces. Mangala game is played with 48 pieces. Players distribute the 48 pieces in a way that each pit has 4 pieces. The 6 small pits lying side to side in front of each player is the area of that player. The 6 small pits in front of the opponent is the area of the opponent player. Players' aim is to collect as much piece as they can in their treasuries. The one who has the most number of pieces at the end of the game wins the game set.

7. SPORTS COMPETITIONS IN NATIONAL KINDS OF HUNTING "SALBUURUN"

(Complete game hunting with birds of prey and dogs)

7.1. "Burkut Saluu» - hunting with eagles.

Composition of the team - 6 people: 1 leader and 5 berkutchi (hunter with eagles). According to the rules of the game "Salbuurun" contest is conducted as follows: the participants are experiencing their golden eagles in the following two exercises - "Chyrga" and "Undok".

"Undok"

Eagle is seated at a distance of 200 meters in this contest. At the judge's signal the hunter begins to holler his/her eagle, holding the bait. It is estimated time of arrival to the arm eagle. Each participant is allowed to holler his/her eagle once, standing on the ground or on horseback.

Winner of "Burkut Saluu" is determined by the number of points earned in the two competitions - "Undok" and "Chyrga"

Requirements for participants of "Burkut Saluu":

- Each participant has to perform in a national dress;

- Have a passport for birds of prey and the international veterinary certificate of vaccination of birds of prey, as well as a certificate from CITES (the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora).

"Chyrga"

Here, every eagle (the hunter with an eagle) starts his eagle in the direction of plaster cast made from the skins of foxes, whose rider galloping drags. According to the requirements, the eagle has to fly to the dummy, moving at an average speed, and grab it. The time and speed of flight of birds is estimated. The level of training an eagle is determined by this exercise. Berkutchi scores a point. According to the rules, a hunter can run their eagle only one time.

7.2. "Dalba oynotuu" - flying falcon to the lure.

Composition of the team - 6 people: 1 leader and 5 Kushchu (falconer).



Speed of the falcon is estimated by running on the lure in this form of competition. 2 minutes is given to each kushchu (falconer) to test his falcon. During this time, the bird should fly from the air to simulate an attack on the lure, falconer who turns on the rope. It lures made of feathers partridge, pheasant and pigeon taken from the tail and wings. According to the rules, the judge note how many times the falcon flew and simulated attack on the lure. The winner is determined by the greatest number of points.

Requirements for participants of "Dalba oynotuu":

- Every falconer must act in national dress;

- Have a passport for birds of prey and the international veterinary certificate of vaccination of birds of prey, as well as a certificate from CITES (the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora).

7.3. "Taigan jarysh" – Dog's running between breed rock hounds.

Composition of the team - 6 people: 1 leader and 5 owners of dogs.

Dog agility is determined by the speed it runs at a distance of 350 meters. Dogs chase the dummy of the fox or hare skin, with which the rider rides at a speed of 60-65 km/hour, or dummy pulls a special apparatus. Judges evaluate the time in which the dogs finished first. Five dogs release at the same time after the judge's signal each time.

When competition dogs in the race held initial, semifinal and final races in which the determined dog agility. If during the race dogs will prevent each other or one another dog tries to bite, then this dog is out of the race, and the dog, which is prevented is allowed to participate in the re-match. Owners of dogs who have won first, second and third place in the final race, the prize-winning places are awarded.

Requirements for participants of "Taigan jarysh"

- Every participant must perform in national dress;

- Have a passport for the dog and the international veterinary certificate of vaccination of dogs.
