Equip	Target	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2m wide, 2.66 m height, 5-6cm thick - Needs over 0.5cm tick rubber plate at the front - 145m from the shooting line - 3 Target system (This is to ensure fair and balanced conditions during competition.) - Needs at least 5m distance within each target. - The angle has to be 15° from the ground. 	
	Bow	Rubber fronted	
Area	Field	- The distance between the archers should be over 80cm	





Rules	Shooting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Total of 15 arrows, 3 sets of 5 arrows.- Every person shoots one arrow, and add all the scores- One must shoot the arrow in 30sec- If the arrow falls within 1m distance, it's considered not shot.
	Scoring	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Hitting the target's face: 1 point- Anywhere else: 0 point- Judges register a hit or miss by flag, or occasionally electronically by signal.
